Governor Kathy Hochul is the 57th Governor of New York State, and its first female Governor.

Governor Hochul began a career in public office on her local Town Board in Hamburg. She went on to serve as Erie County Clerk and represent New York's 26th Congressional District in the U.S. House of Representatives. Prior to her tenure as Governor, she served as the Lieutenant Governor of New York State.

Governor Hochul holds a bachelor's degree from Syracuse University and a law degree from Catholic University in Washington, D.C. She began her legal career working at a firm in Washington, D.C. and later served as legal counsel and legislative assistant to Congressman John LaFalce and Senator Daniel Patrick Moynihan. She was instrumental in drafting legislation related to campaign finance reform, immigration reform, and combating drug abuse.

Back home, Governor Hochul helped her mother start a flower & gifts shop and established a downtown business alliance, advocating for small businesses — including minority- and women-owned businesses.

1. <u>ABILITY TO LEAD THE ENTIRE STATE</u> – What contact and experiences have you had with parts of the state, other than where you currently reside, which demonstrate your recognition of the geographic, demographic and economic diversity of the state and your ability to provide leadership on behalf of all New Yorkers?

Governor Hochul has been elected to represent the State of New York at the local, state, and federal levels. Throughout her tenure in public service, she has worked to build a stronger, more equitable State for all New Yorkers, and as a statewide official, she has visited all 62 New York counties to ensure voices across the State are heard.

2. <u>KNOWLEDGE OF THE ISSUES</u> – What issues do you believe are of most concern to voters in rural counties, and what will be your message in addressing those issues?

Governor Hochul's administration has committed to several initiatives that will positively impact rural communities and address some of the most pressing issues they face, including:

- Expanding the state's digital infrastructure with over \$1 billion in new investments to provide affordable broadband access to rural communities including a rural broadband grant program and a build-free initiative for rural broadband deployment;
- Revitalizing New York's rural economies by creating and investing in the NY Forward program designed to advance the renaissance of smaller downtowns;
- Recruiting medical professionals to work in underserved areas by increasing funding for the "Doctors Across New York" program, creating a "Nurses Across New York" program, and expanding the SUNY Pre-Medical Opportunity and the Diversity in Medicine Programs;
- Launching a comprehensive five-year housing plan that will create and preserve 100,000 affordable homes in both urban and rural communities; and
- Improving the housing stock of rural rental properties.
- 3. <u>PARTY BUILDING</u> How have you expressed and demonstrated a commitment toward building our party statewide and what are your ideas for future party building, specific to rural counties?

By exhibiting strong and effective leadership, Governor Hochul is entering the 2022 election having earned the support of a broad Democratic coalition — receiving endorsements from hundreds of elected officials and county committees throughout the State. By building a sense of collaboration and fostering key partnerships among her Democratic colleagues, the Governor has been able to deliver meaningful results for New Yorkers — enacting more than 400 pieces of legislation and guiding our State through a global pandemic. Over the next four years, Governor Hochul is committed to strengthening the party by ensuring representatives from every corner of the State can contribute to building a stronger New York.
